We understand that coming to college can be a big financial commitment, so to encourage the success of our students we've developed a number of financial assistance packages to suit their needs. Discretionary Awards are intended to assist students with the cost of their tuition fees (this includes assistance with examination and registration fees). If students are successful with their application they must enrol within 2 weeks of confirmation of support. Failure to enrol within this period of time may result in support being withdrawn.

Discretionary Awards offer financial assistance to students who are in employment but are encountering financial barriers to learning. Exceptions will be made for those students in receipt of Working Tax Credits when there is no other alternative fee remission. It is funded by the Skills Funding Agency (SFA).

Please note students will not be able to apply for continued funding for the same level of course (except where the course duration exceeds one academic year).

THERE IS NO AUTOMATIC ENTITLEMENT TO A DISCRETIONARY AWARD. Each application will be assessed and if funds are available support will be allocated on a first-come first-served basis. Funding is not guaranteed.

If you apply for this award you cannot apply for any other bursarys.
